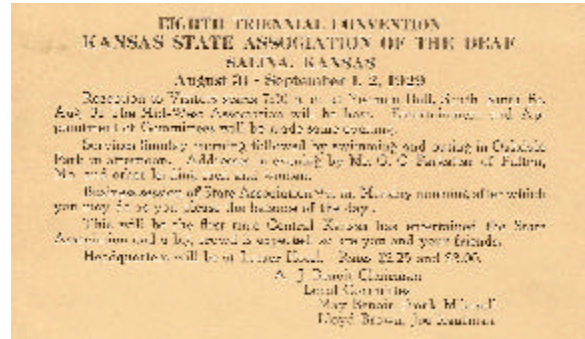

++*It was voted in Wichita that KAD hold its convention during odd years instead of even years so it is not conflict with NAD Convention which meets in even years.*
