KAD Endowment Part 2 (Sunflower Fund)

Now, this is Part Two. In the first video, I explained the J.J. Dold Scholarship. In this video, I will explain the Sunflower Fund.

The Sunflower Fund was created to support Deaf individuals in Kansas of any age. Sunflower Fund awards may be used for Deaf summer camps, Deaf-centered workshops, Deaf-centered classes, etc., as long as they elevate Deaf leadership. This fund helps support opportunities that create and strengthen Deaf leaders and the growth of the Deaf community across Kansas.

Individuals may receive up to one thousand dollars per award. The maximum amount available each year is two thousand dollars. There is no limit to the number of recipients until the fund is fully used. This fund will remain available as long as funding is available.

Applicants must be Deaf or Hard of Hearing and must be Kansas residents. Applications for the Sunflower Fund are accepted year-round. Once the maximum amount is reached, the application will be closed. How to apply: It is the same as the J.J. Dold Scholarship, but the Sunflower Fund application link is listed below it. The application is a JotForm. Applications should complete all required sections and submit the form for review.

Again, the KAD Board will review applications and select recipients. Awards are not paid directly to the recipient. Awards will be paid directly to the program, organization, camp, etc.
